4%

Percentage point gender gap in the high school graduation rate.

43%

Only 43% of bachelor's degrees go to men.

36%

Of boys attain a high school GPA of 3.0 or higher, compared to 51% of girls.

70%

Men account for 70% of the unsheltered population and 63% of people experiencing homelessness.

10%

Among men under 65, 10% don't have health insurance, compared to 8% of women.

64%

In 64% of divorced families, children spent less time with their father than their mother.

79%

The male share of deaths from suicide.

94%

The male share of youth in juvenile rehabilitation.
